

Addiction Liaison Non-Fatal Overdose (NFOD) Response Team

The Addiction Liaison Non-Fatal Overdose (NFOD) Response Team is part of Inverclyde Alcohol and Drug Recovery Service (ADRS) providing assertive outreach to individuals within Inverclyde who have experienced a NFOD from illicit substance use including individuals high risk of experiencing a NFOD due to harmful use of drugs.

The service offers prompt assessment upon referral to facilitate an immediate assertive response approach, supporting people into treatment services and ensure they have access to Injecting Equipment Provision (IEP) including Naloxone.

Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) standards have been incorporated within the Addiction Liaison response pathway to ensure consistent deliver of “no barriers” to treatment for everyone accessing the service. Ensuring people have access to evidenced based treatment with a range of treatment options and the right to make informed choices.

The Addiction Liaison Team will work in partnership with the referrer to establish a joint care plan ensuring all individuals receive appropriate care and treatment of their choice.
